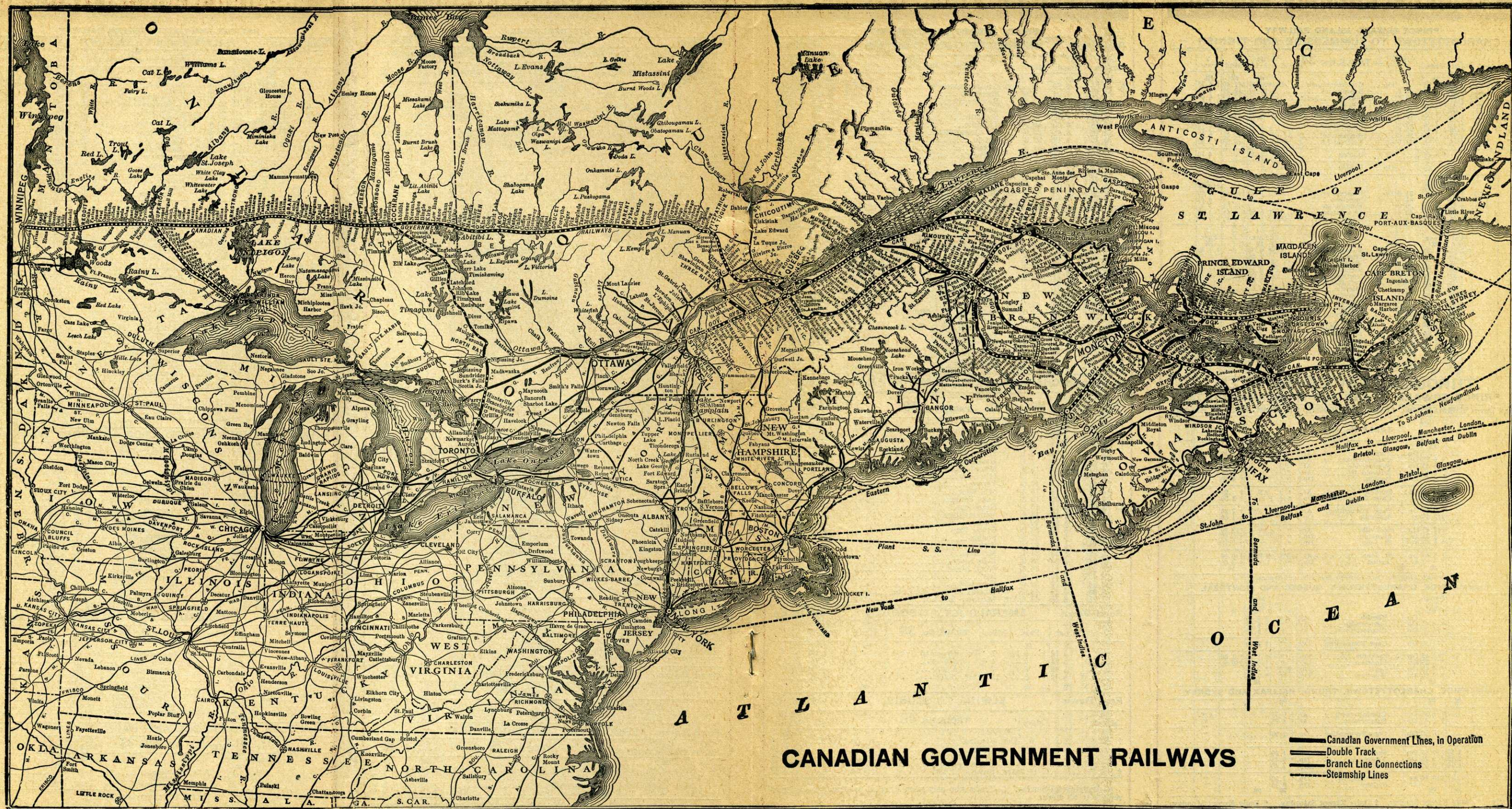

Two persons of the same party, when travelling together and boarding car at same station, will be allowed to occupy a berth on one berth ticket, and four a section on one section ticket, provided each presents first-class railway transportation.

Passengers are advised to secure parlor or sleeping car space by immediate purchase of tickets for same. Sleeping and parlor car accommodation reserved on verbal or telephone application within a radius of five miles from points where space is on sale must be paid for at the time of reservation, or accommodation will not be held.

Reservation by letter, telegram or telephone made by persons outside a radius of five miles from points where space is on sale will be held until train is due to leave if passenger is to board train at starting point of car; or until car reaches station or, junction point if passenger is to board train en route. Exception—Applications from points north of Moncton for accommodation to be reserved on "Maritime Express" or "Ocean Limited" in either direction, will not be held unless paid for at the time application is made.

COLONIST CARS.—Upholstered colonist sleeping cars on Halifax, Quebec and Montreal through trains. Berths in these cars are free to holders of tickets, but passengers must supply their own bedding.

GENERAL INFORMATION

THE TIME TABLES HEREIN ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE.

They show the time trains should arrive at, and depart from the several stations and connect with other trains, but their departure arrival or connection at time stated is not guaranteed.

The time of connecting lines is published for the information of passengers and every care is taken to keep it correct, but this Railway does not hold itself responsible for any errors or omissions therein, nor will it be responsible for delay, detention, loss or injury arising off its lines, and from the acts or defaults of other parties. These conditions apply to all time table advertisements wherever issued by the Railway.

All trains between Armstrong, Ont., and Mont Joli, P. Q., are governed by Eastern Standard Time. Trains South and East of Mont Joli are governed by Atlantic Standard Time. Trains between Armstrong and Winnipeg, and between Fort William and Sioux Lookout are governed by Central Time.

Atlantic Standard Time is in use on the Prince Edward Island Railway.

Type.—Light faced type figures used in this folder denote the time from 12.01 midnight to 11.59 a.m. **Heavy faced type figures** denote the time from 12.01 noon to 11.59 p.m.

Station Ticket Offices are open for the sale of tickets thirty (30) minutes before departure of trains, and passengers are requested to purchase tickets before entering cars. Ten (10) cents additional is charged for one way tickets purchased from Conductors, who sell only to points on their individual runs.

Tickets, one way, of all classes are valid for passage only in the direction printed, and via the shortest route, unless specially otherwise endorsed.

Tickets, round trip—first class, valid for one month from date of issue, are for sale at reduced fares between certain stations. They are not transferable, and are not good for stop over at any intermediate station unless so stated on ticket.

Stop over is allowed on application to Conductor, to holders of first class one way tickets bearing limit of one month or longer, and such other tickets as the Railway designates.

Lost Tickets.—Railways are not responsible for lost tickets.

Upon purchasing tickets, passengers should make a memorandum of the "destination"—"by what Railway issued"—"form"—"Number"—"Consecutive number"—"place and date of sale"—also of the consecutive numbers of their baggage checks.

Children under five (5) years of age, when accompanied by parents or guardian will be carried free; over five (5) and under twelve (12) half fare.

Fares cannot be adjusted by Conductors. In the event of any disagreement with the Conductor relative to tickets required, privileges allowed, etc., passengers should pay the Conductor, take his receipt, and refer the case to the Passenger Traffic Manager for adjustment. Conductors and Agents are governed by rules which they are not authorized to change.

Tickets not transferable.—Tickets are good only for the transportation of the original purchaser, and cannot be used to cover the transportation of any other person.

Mileage books good between all stations on the Canadian National Railways Armstrong, Ont., Montreal and East are on sale at principal stations at twenty eight dollars and seventy five cents (\$31.00) plus War Tax for one thousand (1000) miles. These books are valid for one year from date of issue, and may be issued in favor of one person only whose signatures they must bear, and are not transferable.

Passengers are entitled only to the seat or berth space for which they have paid.

The reference notes used in this folder are explained at the foot of each time table or page.

BAGGAGE

Each passenger is permitted to carry with him in coach, parlor or sleeping car a small quantity of hand baggage only, which will not incommode other passengers.

Obstruction of the car aisles will not be permitted.

Conductors have instructions to remove to the baggage or express car, parcels or articles of baggage found in coaches which occupy too much space or inconvenience passengers, and the owner will be required to pay at destination any charges necessary on same before receiving his property.

Baggage consists of wearing apparel, articles of personal adornment, toilet articles and similar effects in actual use and necessary and appropriate for the wear, use and comfort of the passenger for the purpose of the journey, and not intended for other persons or for sale. Money, jewelry, negotiable papers and like valuables, liquids, perishable or fragile articles should not be included in baggage to be checked. One hundred and fifty (150 lbs.) pounds of baggage, not exceeding one hundred (\$100) dollars in value for each adult, and seventy five (75 lbs.) pounds not exceeding fifty (\$50) dollars in value for each child will be checked free, on presentation of valid transportation on which the adult or child passenger, as the case may be is to travel.

Baggage exceeding the foregoing weights and value limitation will be charged for at current rates, as will also any piece of baggage exceeding 45 inches by the greatest dimension. The Railway does not guarantee to forward or carry baggage on the same train or steamer as passenger nor by any particular train or steamer. In the event of passenger's baggage being lost, damaged or destroyed, the transportation Company will not pay for value in excess to the foregoing value limitation unless the passenger stipulates a greater value at the time of checking and a charge in accordance with current tariff is paid for value in excess to free allowance. Passengers paying for excess value will receive an excess check, which must be delivered to agent when baggage is claimed. All baggage should be addressed. No piece of baggage weighing more than two hundred and fifty (250 lbs.) pounds or any dimensions of which exceed seventy two (72) inches will be checked.

Tickets should be purchased and baggage presented at baggage room at least ten minutes before advertised leaving time of train.

Storage on baggage.—Storage will be charged on each piece of baggage, either inbound or outbound, checked or not checked, remaining at stations over twenty four (24) hours as follows:

First twenty four (24) hours free; second twenty four (24) hours or fraction thereof twenty five (25) cents and for each succeeding day or fraction thereof ten (10) cents per day; minimum charge one (\$1.00) dollar per month, except that baggage received at any hour on Saturday will be stored free until the same hour Monday. Baggage received at any hour on Sunday will be stored until midnight of Monday following without charge; this rule applies to all legal holidays.

CUSTOMS.—Baggage from points in Canada to points in the United States is subject to Customs examination and Customs duties must be paid if dutiable goods are contained therein. United States Customs Officials are at St. John, N. B., Quebec, Montreal, Ottawa, Smith's Falls, Toronto, London, Winnipeg, Vancouver and Collingwood. Passengers from or via these points are recommended to have their baggage examined at either place. Baggage not inspected at either of the above places, or at the Frontier, will be held at Frontier points unless destination is a designated Customs point to which baggage can be bonded, and a special request is made to bond to destination. Passengers should attend personally to having their baggage examined by Customs Officials.

Baggage for flag stations where Agents are not on duty must be claimed at baggage car door immediately on arrival. Baggage from flag stations will be accepted and checked by Baggage man on request of passenger, but not to any point beyond the line of the Railway.

SPECIAL DELIVERY.—Attention is directed to the facilities afforded for checking of baggage to residences, hotels, steamship docks or Railway depots, at Quebec, Montreal, Ottawa, Toronto, Hamilton and other principal points. Transfer charge to be paid to the baggage agent at the time of checking.

If stop over is permitted on ticket and passenger desires to use his privilege, baggage agent must be notified when issuing checks.

Lost articles.—In case of articles left in trains or at stations, notify the General Baggage Agent at Moncton, N. B., or the District Baggage Agent, Winnipeg, giving time and date of loss and description of articles and whether left in station, sleeping or parlor car or coach. The Railway is not responsible for parcels or baggage left at stations or in trains.

Parcel Offices will be found at Halifax, Truro, Moncton, St. John, Lewis and Montreal, Quebec, Winnipeg.

It is unlawful to carry dangerous articles as matches, gunpowder, etc., in baggage.

Bicycles and baby carriages when accompanied by passenger are checked at excess baggage rates for gross weight with a minimum of fifty (50 lbs.) pounds; Minimum charge twenty five (25c.) cents.

Dogs and other animals will not be permitted in cars used for the transportation of passengers, but will be carried only in baggage or express cars and at regular tariff.
